

THE CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I

This organization shall be known as: "The Cody Family" (descendants of Philip Le Cody at Beverly, Mass., 1695).

ARTICLE II

All the descendants of Philip and Martha Le Cody of Beverly, Mass. in 1695 shall be members of this organization.

ARTICLE III

Object: The object of this organization shall be to preserve the records, relics, and family identity of this old Colonial American family, and to promote its unity and friendly relationship.

ARTICLE IV

Permanent Boards: This organization shall have two Permanent Boards, viz: "The Cody Family Memorial Board" and "The Cody Family Historical Board."

ARTICLE V

Officers: The officers of this organization shall be: Honorary President, President, Vice-President, six Regional Vice-Presidents, Secretary, Treasurer, Chaplain, Chairman Memorial Board, Chairman Historical Board.

The six Regional Vice-Presidents shall have jurisdiction as follows:
Eastern Region United States,
Central Region United States,
Western Region United States,
Southern Region United States,
Eastern Region Canada,
Western Region Canada.

The Officers shall constitute the Board of Directors.

NOTE: Since October 27, 1925, the Constitution has been amended at various annual conventions to provide for the change of name of the organization to be The Cody Family Association, to add an Advisory Board consisting of all past presidents, to add regional vice-presidents and alter their territories, to combine the offices of Secretary and Treasurer, and to provide for an Assistant Secretary. Minutes of annual conventions record these amendments to the Constitution.
